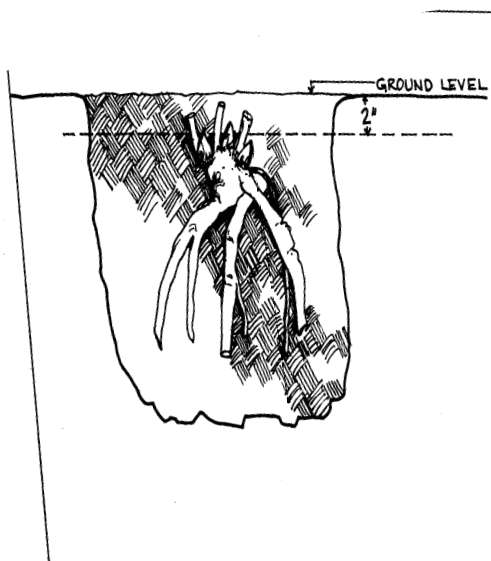


HOW TO PLANT PEONIES

- ⇒ SELECT A PLANTING SITE THAT RECEIVES AT LEAST 5-6 HOURS OF SUNLIGHT A DAY.
- ⇒ DIG A HOLE AT LEAST 15" DEEP AND 15" WIDE.
- ⇒ IF SOIL IS POOR, AMENDMENTS SUCH AS COMPOST ARE RECOMMENDED. ADD A HANDFUL OF BONE MEAL IN THE BOTTOM OF THE HOLE FOR EACH ROOT. ADD BRADFIELD FERTILIZER (OR OTHER ORGANIC FERTILIZER) IN SUBSEQUENT YEARS.
- ⇒ PLANT EYES UP AND ROOTS DOWN AND COVER WITH 1 1/2-2" SOIL- ABOVE THE EYES - NO MORE.
- ⇒ PRESS SOIL IN BETWEEN THE ROOTS WITH YOUR FINGERS TO AVOID AIR POCKETS.
- ⇒ WATER THOROUGHLY. PEONIES DO NOT LIKE WET FEET, SO DO NOT KEEP WET.
- ⇒ MULCH
